Pursuant to Title 40, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 257 (40 CFR §257) Subpart D (aka the CCR Rule) and as specified in 40 CFR §257.102(g), this letter serves as the notification of intent to TCEQ to close the Sludge Recycle Holding (SRH) Pond at the CPS Energy Calaveras Power Station. The initial *CCR Unit Closure and Post-Closure Plan* dated October 14, 2016 and the most recently amended *CCR Unit Closure and Post-Closure Plan* dated August 18, 2023 identify the activities necessary to complete the closure of the SRH Pond by removal of CCR. Both the initial and amended *CCR Unit Closure and Post-Closure Plan* and this notification letter have been placed in the facility's operating records as well as on our publicly accessible CCR website.

A certification by a qualified professional engineer is not required with this notification letter since the closure of the SRH Pond is by removal of CCR.
